hospital and has multiple examination rooms, quarantine rooms, treatment rooms and surgery rooms. All surgery rooms are equipped with imported shadowless lamps, surgical monitors and gas anesthesia machines.

ICVS has state of the art high-end digital X-ray equipment, Mindray ultrasound, VetScan biochemistry analyzer and hematology analyzer, imported AO-ASIF nitrogen drill for orthopedic surgeries, full service laboratory with high-powered microscopes, central air conditioning and heating system, Aquasana water purification system, Blue Air air purification systems and video surveillance security system.

ICVS also has a professional grooming salon and pet shop offering premium pet foods and pet care accessories.

ICVS is a leader in humane animal welfare and adheres to global best practices of the American Veterinary Medical Association (AVMA) and the European Veterinary Medical Associations. Our veterinarians receive training with foreign consultant veterinarians from the USA/Canada and European Union who are board certified in orthopedic surgery, neurology, internal medicine and with exotics and humane animal welfare veterinarian specialists. To help improve animal welfare in China, ICVS trains veterinarians in High Quality, High Volume Spay/Neuter (HQHVSN) best practice techniques that allows each trained doctor to perform 25-35 spay/neuter surgeries per day.
